

# At a Glance: Wedding Reception

*The oldest and largest of the four Inns of Court, it is with no doubt that the rooms available to hire at Lincoln's Inn will provide the most sumptuous and unique backdrop for your special event.*

## Great Hall & Bench Rooms

Opened in 1845 by Queen Victoria, the Great Hall is considered to be one of the most distinguished buildings designed by Philip Hardwick working in the Tudor Revival style.

On the north wall is a huge and magnificent fresco executed by G.F. Watts, the Pre-Raphaelite painter, showing the world's law givers from Moses to Edward I.

Guests enter via the Grand Staircase for arrival drinks in the Bench Rooms. In inclement weather, the East Terrace can be used up until 9pm. The imposing wooden doors are opened to reveal the magnificence of the Great Hall where guests are invited to dine. Dependant on numbers, a dedicated dance floor can be laid out in the Hall ready for the party to continue late into the evening. The Bench Rooms are at your disposal for the duration of your event and make a perfect quiet area to escape to or indeed evening refreshments can be served from these rooms or from the Hall itself.

## Old Hall & Crypt

The Old Hall is a fine example of beautifully maintained Tudor architecture and has many notable features including the wooden screen at the south end, designed by Inigo Jones, and Hogarth's painting of "Paul before Felix" on the north wall. The Crypt beneath the Hall was for centuries used for storage of fuel, food and wine, but now the brick groin vaulting has been restored to its former glory.

Guests enter into the Crypt for arrival drinks. In inclement weather, Gatehouse Court can be used up until 9pm. Guests are invited up the internal staircase to take in the understated splendour of the Old Hall where they are seated to dine. Dependant on numbers, a dedicated dance floor can be laid out in the Hall ready for the party to continue late into the evening. For larger wedding parties, guests are asked to retire to the Crypt for a short moment whilst the Hall is partly cleared to make way for a dance floor. The Crypt is at your disposal for the duration of your event and makes a perfect quiet area to escape to, or indeed evening refreshments can be served here or from the Hall itself.
